

Bowler of the Year Criteria General criteria – all bowlers must bowl Singles Event in City Tournament & qualify/bowl in Top 8 either in the Top 8 group or the alternate selections.

Juniors are only required to have one league.

Junior Boys – High games are 250+ & high series are 650+. 300 games are in a separate category from high games & points are awarded separately.

Junior girls - High games of 200+ & series of 600+. 300 games are in a separate category from high games & points are awarded separately. If there are no 600 series in junior girls, then 500 series will be considered.

Adults are required to have two leagues. Scores considered came from only the leagues that were used to determine composite average for Top 8.

Adult Men – High games are 275+ & series are 700+. 300 games are in a separate category from high games & points are awarded separately. Each category has 10 possible points.

Adult Women – High games are 250+ & series are 700+. 300 games are in a separate category from high games & points are awarded separately. Each category has 6 possible points.
