#### COMMUNITY SERVICE

The Community Service Committee is tasked with raising awareness and funds for our military veterans, BVL, and breast cancer research and education. This year, our funds were donated to our local VA Administration, to the Florida Breast Cancer Research Foundation, and MetaVivor, an organization dedicated solely to Stage 4 breast cancer individuals and research.

As we entered this year with a lower number of sanctioned bowlers, we still planned and carried out our fundraisers for these three organizations. The easiest way to initially raise funds is with our league collections and dedicated tournaments. These events happen throughout the Winter Season.

We hold two fundraising mail-o-gram tournaments which take place during your night of league bowling: one in February and one in November. We make this easy for all league bowlers to enter with a donation entry fee of \$10.00. Half of that fee is your entry and half is a donation. Our first mail-o-gram benefiting BVL was held the week of November 11-16, 2024, and our winners were Christine Clark, Laz Flores and Ashlyn Cruz. Our second mail-o-gram benefiting Meta-Vivor was held the week of February 10-15, 2025. Our winners for this tournament were Arnie Ginsburg, Lori Garcia and Brandon Escoto. An interesting fact is that since we started these mail-o-gram tournaments in 2015, we have never had a duplicate winner.

And finally, we hold two large in-house tournaments for our charities. Our Baker's Doubles for BVL held in May, 2025, and our Rolling Towards a Cure held in October, 2024. Our Rolling Toward a Cure tournament is by far our biggest event with over 100 participants. It is one in which family and friends come to participate in our bowling tournament, many basket raffles, 50/50 share the wealth drawings, baked goods and ways and means table. We have something for everyone.

I am pleased to share that through your participation and donations, we will donate \$3,719.15 to our local VA Administration, \$1,128.00 to MetaVivor and \$7,776.58 to Florida Breast Cancer Foundation. All large sums thanks to you, the bowlers of Greater Miami.

### Committee Report for Annual Meeting July 12, 2025

#### **Tournament Committee**

During the 2024-25 Association year the committee held several regular tournaments and one special tournament; an Adult/Youth Tournament, Women's, Open and Youth City Tournaments, Senior Tournament, Rolling Towards the Cure Tournament and the Top 8 Invitational Tournaments. Our special tournament was a BVL Bakers Doubles Tournament.

July 21, 2024 the Annual Top 8 Invitational Tournament was held. There were 8 men & 8 women who qualified and 8 men & 8 women who qualified in the Senior Division. The only requirement is for each bowler to have bowled at least 60 games in the past season in 2 leagues.

On October 18, 2024 the Annual Rolling Towards A Cure Tournament was held in support of Breast Cancer Research. There was a total of 134 entries, including Women's division, Open division, Youth Division & a scratch division. There was a total donation to FBCR of \$7,776.00 from the proceeds of the tournament as well as donations from individuals and other fund-raising events for this cause.

On December 7 & 8, 2024, the GMUSBC Association held the Annual Youth City Tournament.

The breakdown of entries is as follows;

Doubles had 22 entries
Singles had 51 entries
All Events had 19 entries

On January 11th & 12, 2025, the Annual Women's City Tournament was held. We had a doubles division with an optional singles event as well as optional scratch.

The breakdown of entries is as follows:

Women's Doubles had 15 entries Doubles Scratch had 3 entries Women's Singles had 21 entries Scratch Singles had 9 entries All Events had 28 entries

March 1 & 2, 8 & 9, 2025 were the dates for the Open Adult City Tournament.

The breakdown of Entries for the Open Adult City Tournament is as follows:

Open Team had 37 entries
Open Doubles had 71 entries
Open Singles Division had 122 entries
Open All-Events had 147 entries
Scratch Events had a total of 121 entries

The Senior 50+ Tournament this year held on April 6, 2025 had 53 entries.

On May 18, 2026, the Association held a BVL Bakers Doubles Tournament. There were 25 entries in the tournament. There was a total donation to BVL of \$3,719.00 from the proceeds of the tournament as well as donations from individuals and other fund-raising events for this cause.

The Annual Invitational Top 8 Tournament Youth Division was held on June 14, 2025. This year there were 8 Youth Boys & 7 Youth Females who were able to participate. Every Youth received SMART scholarship money. There was a total of \$2900.00 deposited in the SMART accounts for the youth.

The Adult Top 8 event will be held on July 27, 2025.
